PARISH MASS BOOK: - THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD: - YEAR A is on page 118 - 120 of the Parish Mass Book, Preface of the Baptism of the Lord on page 68. Creed on pages 11 – 12.

CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH: CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH: (CCC 535) Jesus' public life begins with his baptism by John in the Jordan. John preaches "a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins". A crowd of sinners - tax collectors and soldiers, Pharisees and Sadducees, and prostitutes - come to be baptized by him. "Then Jesus appears." The Baptist hesitates, but Jesus insists and receives baptism. Then the Holy Spirit, in the form of a dove, comes upon Jesus and a voice from heaven proclaims, "This is my beloved Son." This is the manifestation ("Epiphany") of Jesus as Messiah of Israel and Son of God.

RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION: - As a reminder during Holy Communion those receiving may do so in the usual reverent manner either on the hand or on the tongue. If you are not receiving Holy communion, please feel free to come forward with your arms crossed to receive a blessing. Thank you for your cooperation.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA): - We warmly invite all those interested in learning more about the Catholic faith to join our Next R.C.I.A session on **Sunday, 11th, 18th, 25th January 2026 at 3.00pm for an hour and on Tuesday 13th, 20th, 27th January at 4pm for an hour** in the Joe Kairis Suite. The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is the process through which adults are welcomed into full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. It offers an Opportunity to explore the faith, ask questions, and prepare to Receive the Sacraments of Initiation (Sacrament of Baptism, Holy Communion, and Confirmation).

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION SESSION: - Our next Confirmation session will take place on **Saturday, 7th February 2026 at 5:30pm** in the Joe Kairis Suite followed by **6.30pm mass**.
